Georgia Public Web (GPW) General Web Site Privacy Policy

GPW is committed to safeguarding the privacy of our Web site visitors and users of our Web site services. This privacy policy details our commitment to protect information regarding our visitors or users collected through our Web site and the limited manner in which we will use that information to provide you services through your use of our Web site. By visiting or using our Web site, you consent to the collection and use of your information by us as set forth in the policy currently in effect. However, you may choose at any time to restrict the collection or use of your information as further described in this policy. We may from time to time change our privacy policy with or without notice, so please check it regularly for any changes or updates. Information We Collect and How We Use It

Aggregate and Anonymized Information

Visiting Our Site.

When you visit our Web site to browse, we may collect and store aggregate and anonymized information about you such as the domain name and host from which you access the Internet (e.g., aol.com), the IP address of your computer, your browser software and operating system, the date and time you access the site and the Internet address of any Web site from which you link directly to our site or to which you link after visiting our site. We may use this information to measure the number of visitors and repeat visitors to sections of our site, to calculate the average time spent on our site, to determine from where our visitors link and to where our visitors link from the site and to help us make our site more useful. For example, we may organize and analyze IP addresses so that we can provide efficient service, enhance security, monitor appropriate usage and produce traffic volume statistics. This type of aggregate and anonymized information may be shared with third parties, such as when we aggregate and disclose site traffic information for marketing and commercial purposes.

Personally Identifiable Information

Contacting Us or Using our Web Site Services.

When visiting or using our Web site, you may click on an option to contact us, where you may (i) make partnership inquiries; (ii) obtain additional information about products and services; (iii) request customer support; (iv) subscribe to a newsletter; (v) request employment information; (vi) access our customer or partner extranet or (vii) ask questions, make comments or receive feedback.

Use of Personally Identifiable Information.

When you contact us or use our services, we collect Personally Identifiable Information about you. We may also use your email address or other Personally Identifiable Information you provide us to send you additional marketing materials about our products, services, and features but only if you indicate that you wish to be informed of our products, services and features.

Disclosures to Third Parties

Except as otherwise set forth in this privacy policy, we will not reveal any User Information to any other third party without your consent, except that we may share User Information with our business associates or data processors that assist us in administering our services or processing your data. Furthermore, we may also disclose or transfer certain User Information to provide you: (i) the services, products or features you have requested; (ii) to protect your vital interests such as to protect the confidentiality or security of your records; (iii) to comply with law enforcement, government mandate or other legal requirement if appropriate for your protection or in connection with an investigation or prosecution of possible unlawful activity; (iv) to obtain legal advice or (v) for other legally permissible purposes. For Web site visitors or users accessing our Web site from a location in the United States, we may also disclose or transfer certain User Information in connection with a sale, acquisition or merger of our business.

Surveys

From time to time, we may include survey forms on our Web site asking you for contact, demographic or other information. We will only disclose survey responses that contain anonymized data to our business associates or data processors that assist us in administering our offered products and services or other third parties who use our services.

Security

The site employs industry standard security measures designed to protect against loss, misuse or alteration of information you provide us via the site. Cookies

We may use cookies.

Cookies are small amounts of data that we send to your browser and are stored on your computer. We may use cookies to identify you when using our Web site or to make your use of our site easier by saving your status and preferences upon visits to our site. If you do not want us to send cookies to your browser as described herein, then please contact us at sales@gapublicweb.net . If we stop sending cookies to your browser or if you are able to configure your browser to not accept cookies, then it may affect your use of our Web site or services.

Links to Third Party Web Sites

If You Do Not Wish to Disclose User Information
